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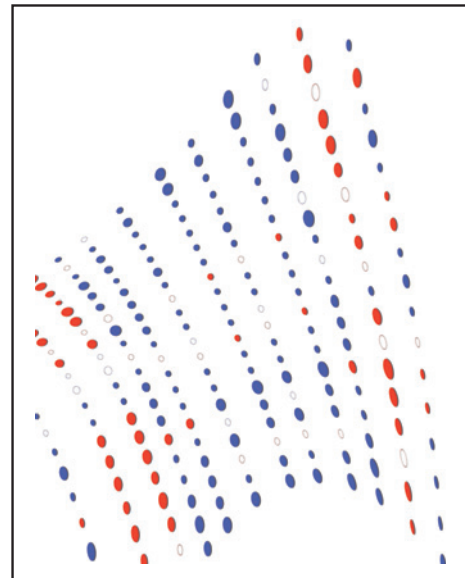
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## ABOUT THE COVER

Epigenetic (5-methyl Cytosine, 5mC) changes in different regions of key genes in oral tongue squamous cell carcinoma. The cover image shows bubble-track images depicting a significant cis-regulatory relationship between gene expression and 5mC DNA methylation for key genes. Blue and orange colors indicate hypo- and hyper-methylations respectively and filled circles indicate a correlation in the expected direction, i.e. hyper-methylation and down-regulation, or hypo-methylation and up-regulation.
